PREPAID REGISTRATION AND RECITAL FEE

Registration and Recital Fee: \$130; includes:

- Registration for a single (1) student (\$25); non-refundable;
- 5 Recital tickets (any combination of shows), non-refundable (\$60); (see bottom of page 3 for additional information)
- 1 Recital tee shirt, non-refundable (\$25)
- Dance Education Fee (\$20), helps underwrite monthly newsletters, tours and events, including Festival of Trees tour, more

Additional Student Registration fee: \$25/each, non-refundable, plus \$25 per recital tee (non-refundable).

BILLING INFORMATION & PAYMENT OPTIONS

We have competitive rates and offer multi-class discounts that also extend to families. Annual tuition per family and costume fees will be calculated at time of registration. Please call 248-380-1666 or email us for additional tuition information.

Distribution of payments will be determined by client choice:

- 1. 10 monthly payments by ACH Debit from your checking account (No service fee; credit card account number must be provided and will be kept on file as backup; withdrawals on the 15th of each month.)
- 2. 10 monthly payments by credit card (PLEASE NOTE: Accounts using a credit card for payment will be charged a \$5.00 per month service fee; Cards accepted: Visa, MasterCard, Discover; processed on the 5th of each month for the withdrawal).
- 3. One-time only full payment due by first class
- 4. Two payments (September 1st and February 1st)

Please indicate your payment method choice at the time of registration.

NOTE: We offer a 'bill to my account' service for clients who maintain either a credit card on file or ACH status. Purchases will be paid, along with monthly tuition and costume fees, on their chosen withdrawal date (5th or 15th of the month). You may 'OPT IN' or 'OPT OUT' on your registration form. Clients who decline this service must pay for all items at time of purchase.

Adds: Will be processed immediately and pro-rated.

Drops: By verbal request in person, or via telephone. Requests must be made prior to the first of the next billing month. Any requests received after the first of the month will be processed in the next billing period.

Missed Classes: Credit will not be given for any classes missed. Make-up classes may be arranged at the instigation of the dancer or his/her family.

RECITAL COSTUME FEES

Non-refundable after December 31, 2018. There is a cancellation fee of \$25/costume. Non-returnable after receipt. Exchangeable for size.

- Deposit for all dancers \$85 per student per class
- Boys' costumes are often separates and, therefore, subject to market price. We will endeavor to secure the most economical, yet appropriate, costumes for our male dancers.

Any additional fees will be due at time of notice. Costume payments will be spread over the months from Sept. – Jan.

NOTE: If an account is not current for costume payments as of December 3, 2018, costumes will not be ordered for those dancers. Client assumes the risk of costumes not shipping in time for Picture Day and/or Dress Rehearsals and Recitals for any orders placed after the primary order in December.

AUDIT CLASSES

Dancers are invited to audit classes by senior faculty. \$15/month tuition fee charged Sept.-June. Assessment for readiness to perform with higher level classes will occur in December. If the dancer qualifies to perform with the audit class, the costume fee (\$85) will be charged to the account and due in January.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES

RETURNING STUDENTS: If we already have your ACH or credit card number on file, simply give us your approval and the classes you wish to take (by phone, fax or email) and you'll be automatically registered.

NEW STUDENTS: Phone, fax, email or bring us your completed registration form and schedule/payment form information (in this packet) and we'll take care of all the details!

ALL STUDENTS: You'll receive a response package confirming classes, payments, and requirements for shoes and apparel.

ABOUT OUR CLASSES

We offer classes for ages 6 months and older, boys and girls, at all levels, beginner through advanced. Two tracks, Traditional and Training, provide many choices.

TRADITIONAL CLASSES - ENROLL THROUGH JANUARY

Grown Up & Me, Preschool, Primary Dance Acro, Primary Ballet & Tap, Primary Jazz, Ballet, Jazz, Tap, Open Contemporary/Lyrical, Open Hip Hop

TRAINING PROGRAM - ENROLL THROUGH OCTOBER

Company Ballet, Company Tap, Company Jazz, Company Contemporary/Lyrical, Open Contemporary/Lyrical, Company Hip Hop, Open Hip Hop, Company Pointe, TEAM, Jumps/Leaps/Turns, Dance Acro

Our primary season is September through June culminating with our annual June Showcases.

NOTE: Classes are organized by age and skill levels. Dancers should expect to remain at a level for a minimum of 2 years.

AGE / SKILL REQUIREMENTS

- Grown Up & Me (ages 6 mo.-3 yrs); must be of qualifying age upon enrollment
- Preschool (Ages 3-4) must be of qualifying age upon enrollment
- Primary Dance Acro (ages 4-7); must be of qualifying age upon enrollment
- Primary (Ages 5-6) must be of qualifying age by December 1
- Level 1(Ages 7-11) must be of qualifying age by December 1
- Level 2 (Ages 8+) must be of qualifying age by December 1
- Open classes (Ages 9+)
- · Company classes based on skill

Our experienced and dedicated senior faculty and office staff will evaluate your dancer to determine the best placement for her or him.

COMPANY AND TEAM CLASSES COMMITMENT/REQUIREMENTS

Company Level classes require consistent attendance and a high level of commitment both personally and to your classmates. Excessive absenteeism is not allowed for any reason within the control of the dancer, i.e., conflicting membership on another team (sports, musicals, etc.).

Individual instructors will determine if a student, and his/her classmates, will benefit from private tutoring (see fee schedule) in the event of a situation out of the control of the dancer, i.e. health or family issues, that affects the dancer's ability to come to or participate regularly in class. Your acceptance of this class placement constitutes your agreement to abide by these rules to maintain your standing at this Company or TEAM level.

Company dancers are required to take Ballet classes to help build a strong dance foundation. This requirement covers all genres: Tap, Jazz, Contemporary, and Hip Hop.

Requirements as follows:

- Company 4 one (1) ballet class required. Must be a performance or ballet technique class.
- Company 5 & 6 two (2) ballet classes required. May be comprised of a performance, ballet technique, and/or a Jumps/Leaps/Turns class.
- Company 6 must be enrolled in a minimum of three (3) disciplines of which two must be Jumps/Leaps/Turns, ballet technique, and/or ballet performance.
- Pre Pointe and Pointe dancers must be enrolled in the minimum number of Ballet classes as dictated by their Level.
- TEAM Participation in the Competitive Dance program requires three (3) ballet classes, Dance Acro, plus technique and choreography classes by genre. Please contact the office for more information.

RECITAL TICKETS - TICKET DAY IS SUN. MAY 5, 2019

5 Recital tickets (any combination of shows) are included in your family registration fee.

Additional advance-purchase tickets are available at the studio on Ticket Day, Sunday, May 5, 2019, or in the office through June 1, for \$13 each. (Tickets are non-refundable after June 1, 2019.)

For tickets purchased on Ticket Day, seat selection will be on a first come/first serve basis. If a client has no preferences for seats, they may turn in their ticket request form prior to Ticket Day, and still receive the advanced purchase price.

Tickets are also available at the door for \$16.

IMPORTANT STUDIO POLICIES

ATTENDANCE Please notify us if a student will not be in class: call 248.380.1666, or e-mail us at csdc5678@dancingcenterstage.com. Students are expected to attend classes regularly. Excessive absences are grounds for elimination from the class and any related performances including June Recitals. Individual instructors will determine if private tutoring (see Specialty Class Rates) is warranted.

<u>DRESS CODE</u> Leotard, tights, dance shorts or a ballet skirt are considered appropriate attire for all ballet, jazz, tap, hip hop and contemporary classes. Proper shoes are mandatory for all classes. *Students improperly attired will not be allowed to participate in class. SEE WEBSITE FOR CURRENT REQUIREMENTS.*

WEATHER CANCELLATIONS Bad weather may cause class cancellations. Phone the studio one hour prior to class time for information. We won't necessarily follow public school closings. If weather conditions throughout the year cause more than 2 cancellations, make-up classes will be scheduled.

PARKING Our allotted spaces are in the rear of the building. Please enter through the Studio Entrance at the back of the building. PLEASE DO NOT BLOCK THE SIDEWALK IN FRONT OF THE STUDIO WHEN DROPPING OFF DANCERS — PLEASE PULL INTO A PARKING SPACE OR DRIVE TO THE REAR ENTRANCE AND DROP OFF THERE.

<u>CLASS VISITATION</u> Parents have an opportunity to view a portion of their child's class on a scheduled basis; advanced notice of visitation days will be provided.

NORTHVILLE PARKS & RECREATION CLASSES (onsite at Center Stage)

Center Stage Dance offers dance instruction for the Northville Parks & Recreation programs. Classes run in Fall, Winter and Spring sessions and drop-in classes over the summer.

Fall, Winter and Spring sessions end with a showcase for friends and family. Please note: Children must be of qualifying age by the first class. All classes are held at our studio.

Classes choices include: Grown Up & Me, Preschool, Ballet, and Hip Hop. We also offer Adult Ballet Fitness and Adult Tap.

Separate registration through the Northville Parks & Recreation Department is required for these classes. Contact them at 248-349-0203 for information.

JAZZ & TAP LINES

Qualified Tap and Jazz dancers will be invited to join a line. Dancers may also choose to audition for a higher level Line. As part of the audition, dancers are evaluated, by guest judges and faculty, in six (6) categories:

- Sequence
- Musicality
- Performance Quality
- Style
- Clarity
- · Quick Study or Recall

Auditions will determine the best placement on one of our four Lines based on age and skill level.

Participation in our Lines is an honor and gives students extra opportunity to practice their performance technique. Each Line performs a piece in our June Showcases, where dancers are recognized for their achievement.

Separate rehearsals are required; the rehearsal schedule will be included with the invitation letter. Additional tuition and costume fees apply. Students are required to sign a Commitment Contract.

REQUIREMENTS

- You must be currently enrolled in the matching technique class at Center Stage.
- Rehearsals begin in February or March; Regular attendance is required. Line members are allowed
 one excused absence. Planned absences are not permitted for mandatory rehearsals.
- Line dancers are expected to participate in all assigned June showcases.

LINE OPPORTUNITIES

Future Stars, ages 6-10

An introduction to the benefits of competitive dance training including developing skills in quick study, performance quality, and commitment to a TEAM. Additionally, dancers are exposed to the concept of progress through repetition (also known as practice, practice, practice!), which helps to build stronger muscle memory, flexibility, stamina, and endurance. Choreography will focus on the story-telling aspect of dance which develops an understanding of the depth of movement beyond the steps. Typically, a contemporary, jazz or musical theater oriented piece will be set on the dancers.

Gold Stars Tap & Jazz, ages 8+

Similar to the Future Stars syllabus, Gold Stars continue to work on their quick study, performance quality, muscle memory, flexibility, stamina, and endurance. Choreography becomes more complicated with a focus on spacial awareness through formation changes and the addition of more complicated tap combinations and jazz tricks, leaps, and turns.

Platinum Company ages 12+ or by invitation

The dancers are expected to have a strong background in dance and a clear ability to take more complicated information quickly. Choreography may now include layering, a higher difficulty of tricks, leaps, and turns, and more intricate details in the movement.

Diamond Company ages 12+

These dancers have achieved a level of skill that allows them to take on complicated and challenging choreography in a short period of time. They are set apart from the Platinum dancer primarily by their ability to very quickly absorb difficult material with a higher level of sophistication.
